

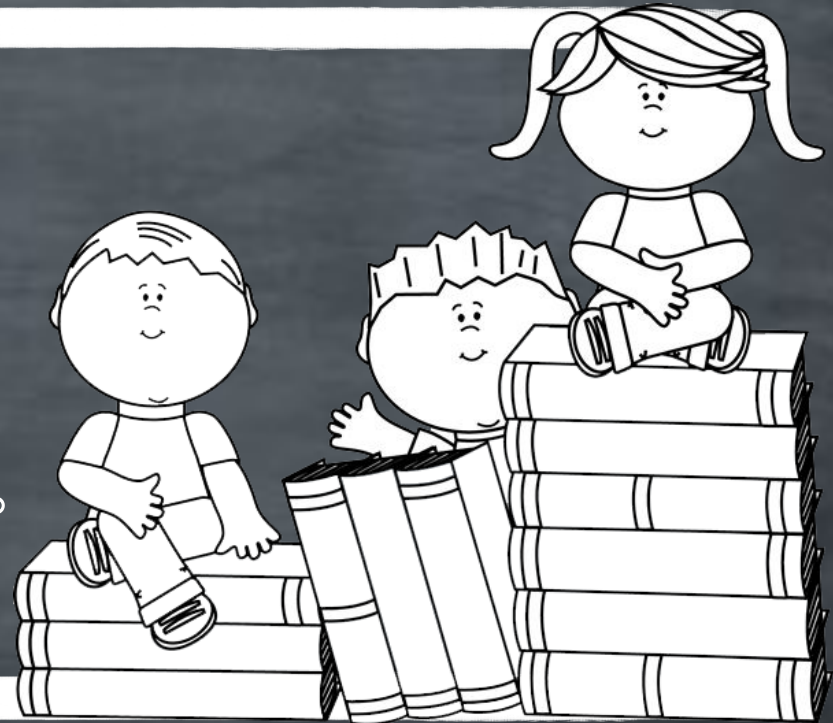
Preschool Kindergarten Partnership



The Preschool Kindergarten Partnership (originally formed in January, 1990) has recently been resurrected. The newly formed committee will initially operate under the same goals as the original. Continue to check back for updated information on what is happening!

Goals

1. To establish a countywide communication network of preschools and kindergartens
2. To define the preschool experiences that contribute to a successful kindergarten year
3. To encourage parents to set appropriate goals for their children
4. To identify preschool children with special needs and to develop ways to share this information with appropriate people
5. To facilitate the children's transition from preschool to kindergarten



Immediate Action Steps

1. A presentation for directors to help them understand the mission of PKP and how it can benefit preschool and kindergarten staff and the children who will be transitioning from PreK to K.
