Early Learning Coalition to increase site visit times

As everyday life slowly gets back to a sense of normalcy, the Early Learning Coalition will begin to lengthen site visit times for many providers to resume normal coaching, monitoring, screening/intervention, and assessments. We will begin to lengthen visit times for coaching and screening/intervention visits up to 1 hour. CLASS observations will resume in April. CLASS Observations and Monitoring Visits will resume typical timeframes (2 hours or more).

We know times are challenging, and we plan to stay in compliance with all of CDC's health and safety recommendations to make our visit as comfortable as possible to you and your staff.

Below is a list of existing ELC staff protocols during site visits. The guidelines are intended to ensure you, your staff and the children you serve remain safe:

- Wear Masks
- Complete a health screening prior to visiting your program
- Practice social distancing

We ask that you help us keep our staff safe as well. Please make sure each one of your program staff members are wearing a mask during the entire site visit, and try to stay at a safe distance during any one-on-one staff interactions during the visit.
