Maximum Grant Awards:

Child Care Centers: \$1000

Family Child Care Homes: \$100

Freestanding or wall mount air purifiers' guidelines:

- Device and vendors will be selected by provider
- H13 or better HEPA filter
- Child Lock

Child Care Provider Eligibility Guidelines :

- School Readiness provider in good standing
- Must serve SR children ages 0 - 5 year-old
- Provider must attest that they will replace filters as recommended by manufacturer
- Submit brief description with information below

(250 words or less)

1. Home or Center
2. Number of Classrooms
3. Current Enrollment and Current Number of SR Children served
4. Proposed purchase including manufacture, description quantity and cost.
5. Total Amount Requested
